Hospital-Based HTA | Robotics & Photonics for Healthcare – Future-ready health technological developments

Eindhoven - On December 08, brilliant minds will gather in Eindhoven to discuss future-ready health tech developments during the 6th edition of the Health Tech Event.

Over 20 speakers will provide gripping insights into the 3 main focus topics of the conference:

- Hospital – Based Health Technology Assessment (HTA)
- Robotics in Cure and Care
- Using Photonics in Healthcare

Ellen Willemse from The Netherlands Study Centre for Technology Trends (STT) will open the conference with a talk on health related tech developments translated into short scenarios of the not-too-near future.

After that, Amit Kumar Pandey from SoftBank Robotics will speak about robots from a societal perspective, highlighting some research directions and results towards achieving social humanoid robot companions, while Paul De Raeve from the European Federation of Nurses Associations will explain why nurses love robots.

The afternoon program will include several parallel sessions dedicated to Hospital-based HTA, Robotics in Health Care, Photonic applications in Care and Cure, as well as Dutch-spoken parallel sessions, powered by Slimmer Leven 2020, with a focus on Changing value chains and Health Food and Wellbeing.

Speakers from the Norwegian Institute of Public Health, Maastricht UMC+, Tyndall Institute, Centre for Process Innovation Limited, Tinybots, PRECEYES, Microsure, Delft University of Technology and University Medical Center Utrecht will tackle into hot topics such as Why we need to stop improvising in healthcare, Leaving out the obvious when designing new robotic instruments, Facts & Fiction in Robotics for Care and Cure.
