Breakthroughs enabled by ICT have to support the EU 2020 challenge to increasing labour participation and independent living with 2 year. Investments will pay handsome dividends not only in generating very viable and worthwhile opportunities, but, also in creating more affordable healthy ageing.'

The **seminar program** includes keynotes on the challenge to accomplish uncompromised, safe and active lives, how innovations in robotics may lead to playful health tech, what is after lifestyle 6.0, and trend watching ongoing intelligence of emerging technologies. Furthermore a broad spectrum of topics will be covered in the breakout sessions such as EIT ICT Labs' innovation activities, health tech challenges in business and law, EIT ICT Labs startups and their business cases, connected health tech products & services.
